We have just returned from our trip to Hungary and Romania. As we often do following a mission trip, this newsletter will have a lot of pictures. More details next month, but we feel this trip was very successful with more than 60 people being born-again, baptized in the Holy Spirit, as well as water baptisms, and a wedding! We also had a special "couples night" in Székelyhíd, Romania where we had a nice meal, played games and gave away some very nice prizes.

Also during this trip, we found a Hungarian language "Superbook" and bought two complete sets for the children's ministry in Botpalad, Hungary and Székelyhíd, Romania. For those familiar with Superbook, this is a newer version (at least newer than the one that was available when our kids were young. Rather than being sucked down into a hole in the ground, this one has a "flying house".

With us on this trip was Thomas Lohnke from Family Church in Langenthal, Switzerland. Pastor Thomas has

been a major blessing whenever he joins us. Also with us for our time in Székelyhíd was Pastor Levi Szandai from Cluj Napoca, Romania. Pastor Levi was a great help with teaching and translation.

After Székelyhíd, we ministered in Uszka, Botpalad, Kölcse, Túrístvándi, Ózd and Bánszállás, Hungary. The theme of every meeting was becoming a new creation in Christ Jesus (2 Corinthians 5:17) and making sure as many as would receive Him would become born again.

Before closing this newsletter, I do need to bring up the need in Székelyhíd for a major roof repair on the church building. As we have mentioned in earlier newsletters, the roof on the church needs to be completely replaced. In an effort to save money, during construction near the end of 2012, used roofing material was put on, and is now the source of a major problem in the building, because there are numerous leaks in the old roofing material. Over the years the wooden decking under the corrugated roof became rotted and porous with water leaking into the sanctuary. The church members have tried to repair the roof, but it is now dangerous to be on the roof because of rotting decking, and water damage. Your help will be greatly appreciated.
