After getting the team together in Budapest, we drove to Székelyhid, Romania where we held a conference at the Light to the Nations church there. The theme from the conference was taken from the scripture above (Isaiah 6:8) *...here I am! Send me*. We emphasized the point that every believer has a part in the end time harvest. Each team member shared powerful messages that challenged and encouraged those who attended.

Sunday after the conference, a graduation ceremony was held for those completing the course of study in the LTTN video Bible school. We were also able to present pastor Karcsi Hendre with all 3 years of updated videos for the Bible school. Uszka, Botpalád and Ózd also receive the updated videos. There has been such an excitement about the teaching they have been receiving, that they have already started another year of the Bible school in Székelyhid.
